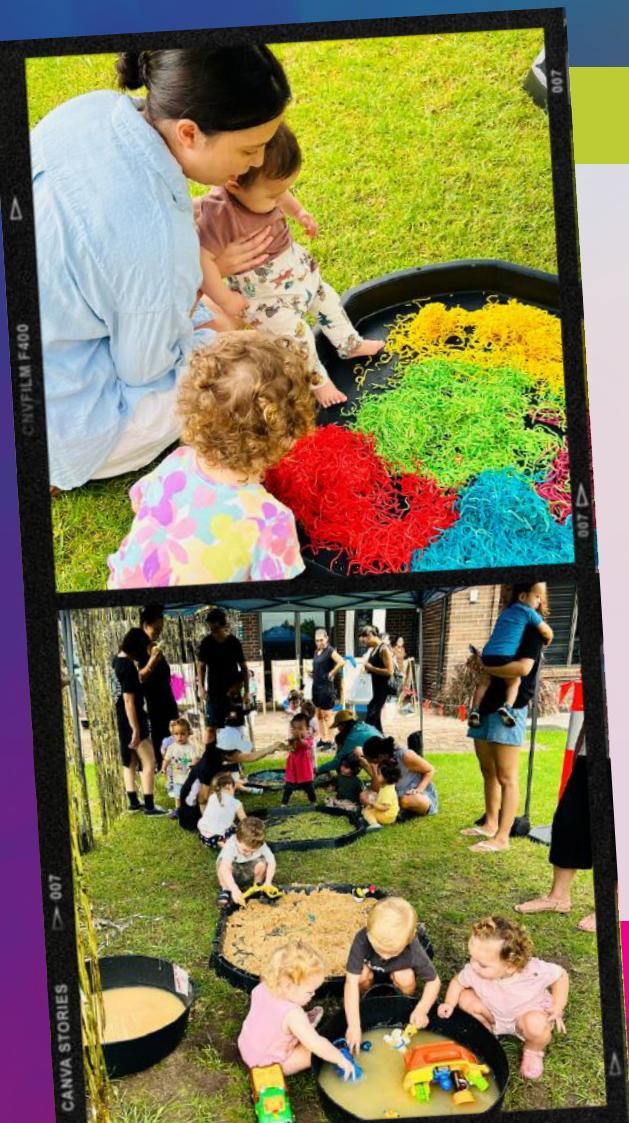

Frequently Asked Questions

Q. Does the fee include the venue hire?

A. Yes. Our Messy Play packages include exclusive hire of The SECC Hub for 3.5 hours. This is broken down into one hour of set-up, 1.5 hours in facilitated Messy Play, and one hour of pack-down. You'll have your Messy Play facilitator and Function Coordinator on hand to support you and make pack-down a breeze.

Q. What are the hall inclusions?

The SECC Hub is a large, friendly space in the old Coronation Hall at 1007 Botany Rd, Mascot. First things first - if you haven't seen it, you need to come and visit. Simply reach out to our Function Coordinator to book a viewing. The building is a mid-century gem with high ceilings, a large open-space hall and proscenium arch stage, naturally accompanied by blue velvet curtains. It's a retro community hall that's been hosting community events and parties since the 1950s. The facility boasts a long list of inclusions, from furniture, outdoor dining areas, and commercial kitchen facilities that are available upon request. Our Messy Play package includes access to refrigeration and food storage areas. A third of the hall encumbers activities suited more to the 6+ age group, featuring pool tables, basketball hoops, air hockey, and ping pong. Additional spaces you can access include the courtyard, community library and lounge area.

Q. What is the maximum capacity of the hall?

A. The maximum capacity of the hall is 80 guests. This can include a combination of children and adults; however the Messy Play activity is limited to 40 children.

Q. What is the role of the Function Coordinator and Messy Play facilitator?

A. This dynamic duo will take all the stress out of setting up and running your child's celebration. Our Function Coordinator will assist in setting up, welcoming your guests, catering, on-hand support, and pack-down. Our Messy Play facilitator will set up, facilitate and pack down this glittery, slimy mess.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q. What are the Messy Play activities?

Our Messy Play facilitator will liaise with you as part of the booking process to custom-make Messy Play activities to suit your child's birthday party. The Messy Play activities include sensory play and materials such as slime, sand and water. But don't panic reading this. The SECC team cleans up on the day.

Q. What do I need to do to create the invitations?

Relax! Our inhouse design and communications team has you covered. Our designer and copywriter will reach out to you via email and give you four templates to choose from. Once you have chosen your template, we will ask for your event information and send you a draft. Once you're happy with the design and wording, digital copies will be sent to you. Four rounds of design edits are included as part of this package, and must be completed over the span of one working week.

Q. Why should I choose a "Party with Purpose"?

When we celebrate a child's milestone and begin to plan a party, the to-do list gets longer and longer. Venue, activities, decorations, catering... Our Party with Purpose activities are designed to be cost-effective. It's a one-stop shop, making the job of hosting a party *so much easier*. Not to mention, the party fee goes directly to supporting community members in crisis.

Q. What do I tell my caterer?

This is where your Function Coordinator comes in. If you're using a caterer, ask them to contact our team to talk through the specifics of their requirements. Please note, this package is limited to refrigeration, kitchen benches and waste removal. This does not include access to cooking facilities.

Q. I'm self-catering. What do I need to know?

Don't stress. Just bring along platters of food that can be stored, refrigerated and brought out for guests as needed. In the past, we've had food ranging from delivered pizzas and sandwich platters and cheeseboards. Simply reach out to our Functions Coordinator to discuss further.

Q. What items can I use from the Toy Library?

As part of this package, 10 large-ticket toys can be incorporated in your venue hire. This is made from a selection of baby and children's push walkers, activity cubes, and giant outdoor games.

Q. What's included in the tea and coffee station?

Included in this package is a simple tea and coffee station with hot water urns, sachets of instant tea, coffee, and sugar. This is displayed with disposable, biodegradable cups. Fresh full cream milk will also be provided. You're most welcome to bring additional teas and coffees to your liking.

Q. What's included in the customised foyer design on SECC's TV displays?

We offer you a display of a digital welcome image with the details and timing of the event. You can provide the design team with a picture of your child for this image, and this will be broadcast across two screens in the welcome area/ foyer facing Botany Rd.

Q. What age group is this suited to?

This package is most suitable for children from 12 months through to five years old. Messy Play encompasses finger painting through to exploring sensory materials. Perfect for inquisitive little hands.

COLOUR SPLASH

Recommended age group: 4+

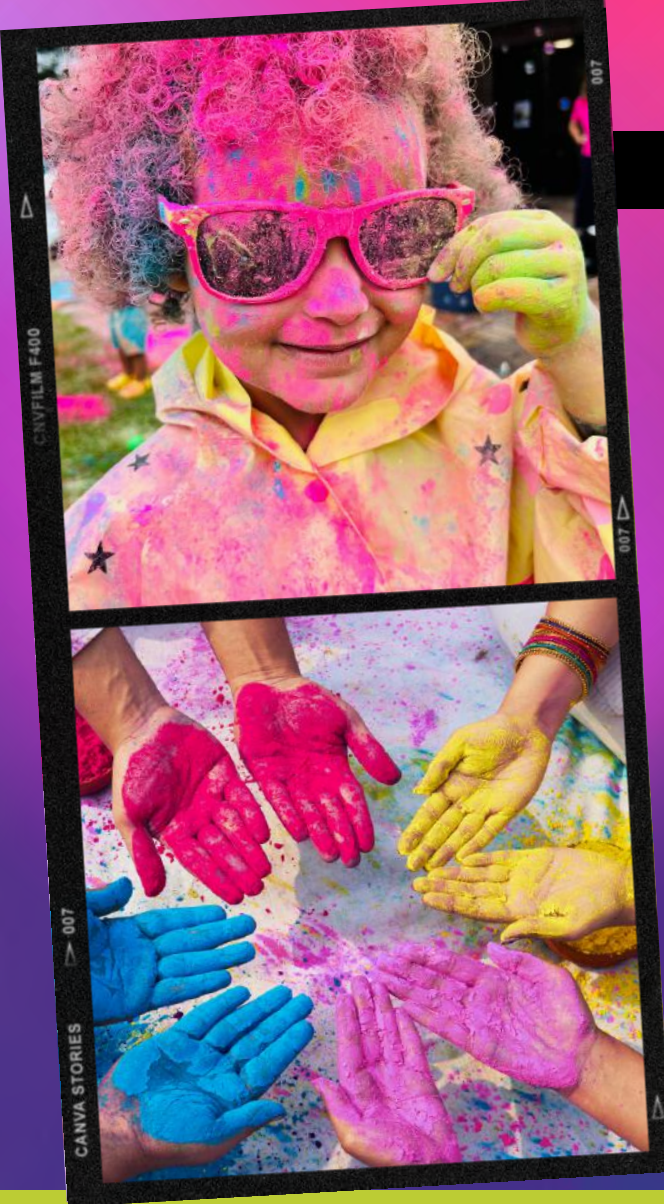

Q. Where can I host the Colour Splash party?

You can host the party in a backyard or outdoor venue of your choosing. This activity is perfect for outdoor green spaces.

Q. How long does the Colour Splash go for?

The Colour Splash runs for 15 mins and can be accompanied by music of your child's choosing. Our party facilitator will host old-fashioned games devised around your child's favourites, such as the three-legged race, sack games, and egg-and-spoon race. Our party facilitator will be on hand to help with clean-up, and any other party games.

Q. Is the colour pigment safe?

Participants take part in the Colour Splash at their own risk. The colour/holi powder used is made of 98% cornstarch and 2% permitted colours. The manufacturer is an ISO 9001-2005 certified Crisil rated company producing the highest quality product. The powder is not considered hazardous. Although colour powder washes out very easily, we advise you not to wear your best clothes or most expensive shoes.

Q. What should we wear?

Dress code is white! White clothing splashed with rainbow powder makes for the best possible photos. We also encourage little ones to wear raincoats if they wish. Please bring your own sunglasses for your eye protection.

Q. What age is the Colour Splash best for?

The activity is ideal for little ones four and over.
